

## Annexure B

**Terms and Conditions**

(Partner Institution may decide to share all/ relevant sections of the document with the students)

**1. Selection Criteria of Scholars**

- 1.1 Should be an Indian citizen.
- 1.2 Should wish to pursue undergraduate engineering degree in Software, Telecom/ Electronics or Agriculture or an MBA/ PGDBM or a masters degree (M.Sc) in Agriculture
- 1.3 Should be a regular student of the Institute
- 1.4 Girl-students and disabled students are encouraged to apply
- 1.5 Scholarship is offered on merit-cum-means basis

**2. Post-Selection Requirements**

- 2.1 The scholar is required to provide bank details to Bharti Foundation immediately after being awarded Bharti Scholarship.
- 2.2 The scholarship installment cheque will be in the name of the scholar, but will be handed over to the Institute to be handed over to the scholar.
- 2.3 The scholar is required to send a confirmation letter to Bharti Foundation acknowledging the receipt of scholarship cheque within 10 days after its receipt.

**3. Release of Installments**

- 3.1 The scholarship amount will be disbursed to the scholar at the beginning of every semester (or as agreed between Bharti Foundation and Partner Institution)
- 3.2 Bharti scholar needs to send a request letter within 15 days after the announcement of the result, giving details of his/her academic achievements in the last academic year and letter of recommendation from the head of the Institute (as per the given format). Subsequent installments for scholarship will be disbursed to the scholar based on the following criteria.
  - Scholarship should be recommended by the head of Institute
  - Scholar should have secured CGPA not less than 7.0 points (or as agreed between Bharti Foundation and Partner Institution), for both UG and PG courses
  - Scholar should have an attendance record of at least 80% of academic days attended
- 3.3 In case there is a change in the course fee/ hostel fee by the Institute, it should be communicated to Bharti Foundation by a letter from the Institute. Bharti Foundation may consider changing the scholarship amount, subject to the maximum limit of Rs 50,000/- p.a, based on actuals.

**4. Reasons of Disqualification**

- 4.1 A change of stream after allotment of the scholarship
- 4.2 Non-performance or dropping out

**5. End of Scholarship Period**

Bharti Foundation team will conduct an 'End of Scholarship' interview with the scholars and take annual feedback from the professor-in-charge of Bharti Scholarship Scheme deputed by Partner Institute in order to assess the impact of the scheme.



**6. Additional points in discussion with Partner Institution (XIM)**

- 6.1 Course Fee:** XIM's course fee is Rs. 2,00,000 p.a., but since BSS's maximum limit is Rs. 50,000 p.a., scholarship will be announced for Rs. 50,000/- p.a. only.
- 6.2 Important Dates:**  
a. Recommendation by XIM to Bharti: July end
- 6.3 Selection criteria for Scholars:** XIM agrees to Bharti's selection criteria. *The selection matrix sheet attached as enclosure A*
- 6.4 Scholarship disbursement timings:** Bharti will disburse scholarship in two installments per year of Rs 25,000 each
- 6.5 Scholarship disbursement criteria for each remaining semesters:** A scholar should get at least SGPA (6 out of 8) points as well as recommendation of Partner Institution, to continue as a Bharti scholar.
- 6.6 Promotion of BSS:** Admission Prospectus for this year has already been printed. BSS will be advertised in prospectus next year. However, this year BSS will be promoted in intranet as well as on institute's website. *The general write-up on the Bharti Scholarship Scheme is attached as Enclosure B*
- 6.7 Scholar's Non-performance:** Non-performance of scholar in any semester will lead to disqualification of scholarship. In this incident the next best scholar, fulfilling the selection criteria, will be awarded scholarship for the remaining period.
- 6.8 Actions in different cases of scholar drop out**  
a. Drop out: Disqualified.  
b. Change of stream: Disqualified  
c. Medical Grounds: The student continues as a scholar, but BF does not have to pay any additional amount, even though the scholar will be paying fee for the semester that s/he is repeating.
